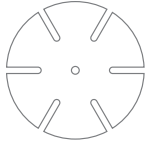

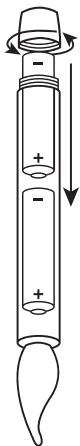
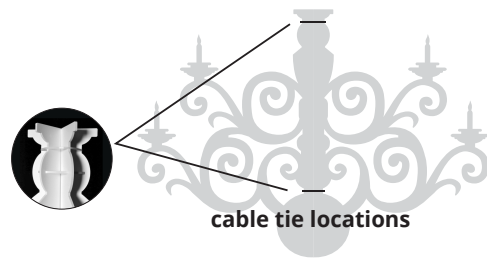

Begin with the 4 slotted discs, working on a surface for support. Slide one disc onto each of the 4 slots of a single segment of the chandelier. While holding this section, add another chandelier segment. Continue with remaining segments around the discs.

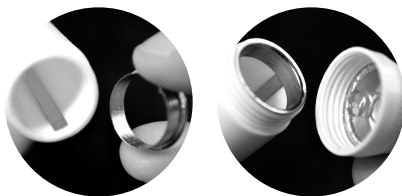


To secure the **Grandelier**, use a provided cable tie around each of the two narrowest points on the center shaft to lock all the sections together. One is located near the top, the other is just above the large ball base as illustrated below. Tighten the cable ties firmly and clip the ends for a cleaner look.



LED Candle Instructions

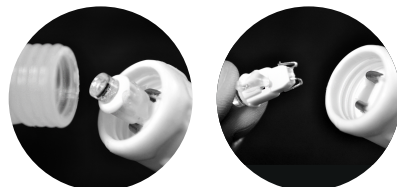
Each Grandelier comes with 12 specialized battery operated, flickering LED taper candles. You will need a total of **24 AA batteries** for them to operate **700+ hours**.



With the candle *inverted*, unscrew the base cap and insert 2 batteries as indicated. Be careful that the metal ring at the opening does not fall loose. If this occurs, carefully replace the ring, resting *on top* of the metal strip inside the candle.

Candles will be **on** when the base is screwed on tightly. To turn the candles **off**, *slightly* unscrew the base. **Remove batteries for long-term storage.**

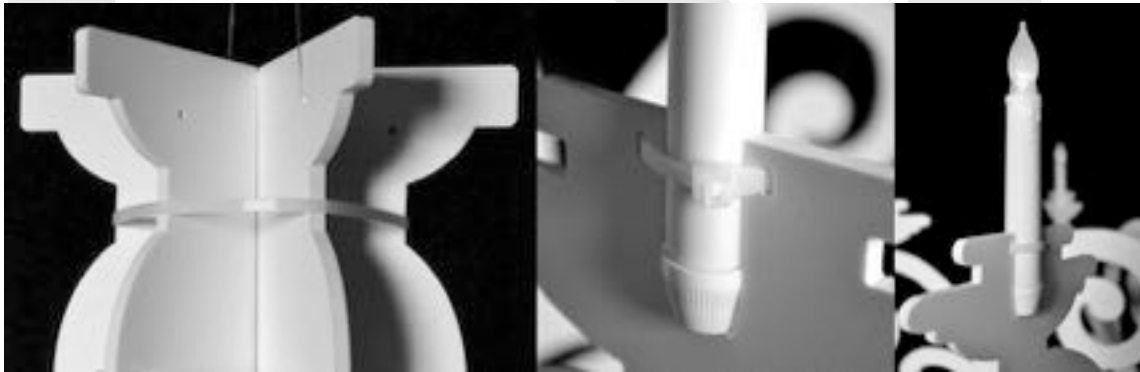
HANDY TIP: In the rare instance that the LED has come loose inside the flame tip, it can be *easily* repaired by unscrewing the flame tip, and securing the LED in its socket with a little hot glue for future assurance.



Once you have inserted the AA batteries into all 12 of your LED candles, you are ready to install them on your Grandelier. The candles may be easily turned on or off after they are installed and will operate for 700+ continuous hours. Insert one of the shorter cable ties through one of the two small holes in the candle holder and back through the other hole. Place the candle and tighten the cable tie, securing the candle. Trim the end of the cable tie for a clean look.

HANDY TIP: To save time in future installations you may choose to leave these cable ties, or additionally the candles in place depending on your storage and transportation requirements.

Using the desired length of the included monofilament, create a loop between two of the small holes on *opposing* sections at the top of your Grandelier to facilitate level hanging.

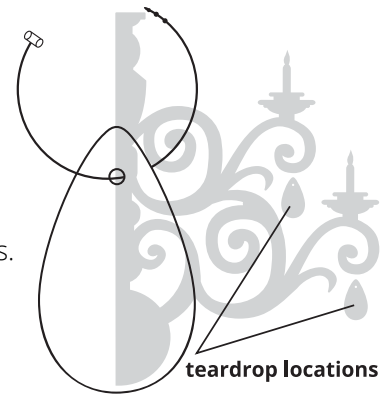


Each teardrop pendant is hung below each candle as illustrated using the included short plastic quick-connect loops.

With proper care, your Grandelier should last a long time and through many uses. It can be cleaned with a little dish soap and water, or using a *Mr. Clean Magic Eraser* to remove surface marks.

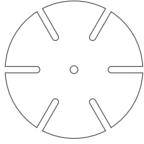

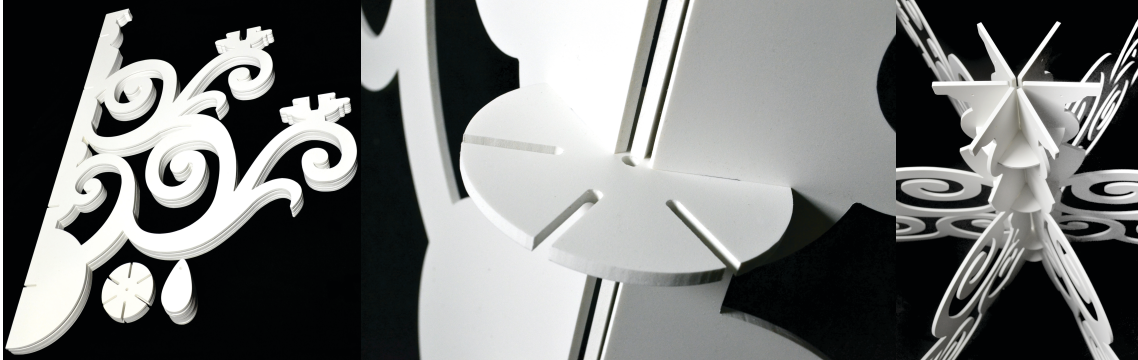

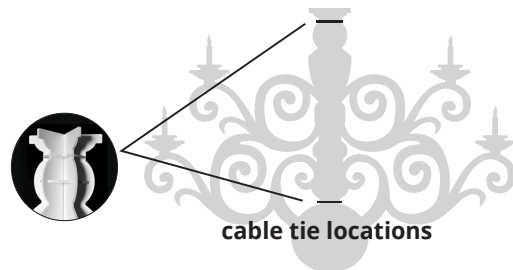


Begin with the 3 slotted discs, working on a surface for support.

Le Petit Grandelier may stay assembled with nothing further, but to ensure that it remains assembled and to aid in hanging it, use a provided cable tie around each of the two narrowest points on the center shaft to lock all the sections together. One is located near the top, the other is just above the large ball base as illustrated below. Tighten the cable ties firmly and clip the ends for a cleaner look.

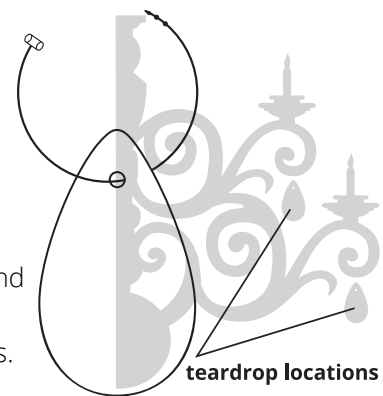


cable tie locations

Using the desired length of the included monofilament, tie each end to opposing sections of the cable tie at the top of your Petit Grandelier to facilitate level hanging.

Each teardrop pendant is hung below each candle as illustrated using the included short plastic quick-connect loops.

With proper care, your Petit Grandelier should last a long time and through many uses. It can be cleaned with a little dish soap and water, or using a *Mr. Clean Magic Eraser* to remove surface stains.
